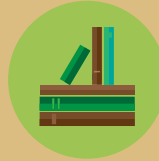

There were **1,135 PEOPLE** in St. Louis jails, including **400 PEOPLE** at the Workhouse jail.

As of June 25, 2019 there were **1,023** in custody, including **303** in the Workhouse jail.
